Summer 2022 External Examinations

Over the next few weeks and months, your son / daughter will continue to be involved in assessments and internal mock exams that will prepare them for their external examinations in the summer of 2022. A timetable of the external exams will be issued to pupils in due course.

Certain courses will also have non-examined units that contribute to the overall grade of your son / daughter's qualification. These units are called non-examined assessment (NEA) and are completed within the classroom. Pupils have and will be informed by their teachers which assessments contribute to their NEA's.

Whilst the school is busy preparing pupils for assessments via external examinations, Welsh Government has asked all schools to devise a contingency plan just in case external exams are cancelled, due to the public health situation deteriorating. Please be reassured that this is only a back-up plan. At this point in the year, it is envisaged that external examinations will go ahead.

Contingency Plan

In the event that external examinations are cancelled, the school will adopt assessment arrangements in line with Welsh Government and WJEC guidance. In this situation, assessments carried out over the next few terms may be used as evidence in the overall judgement of pupil attainment. Therefore, in addition to preparing the pupils for their external exams, internal assessments may contribute significantly to a pupils overall Centre Determined Grade. As a result, it is very important that pupils strive to achieve their very best in all their forthcoming assessments and mock examinations.

To support pupils with this contingency plan, the school has / will inform pupils which assessments will be used to gather evidence as part of the contingency arrangements if exams are cancelled. A timetable of assessments used to gather evidence as part of the contingency arrangements is on the next five pages.
