WOW REACH Postcard Award (10 HP)				
Pupil is rewarded for specific effort in lessons form time social time for representing the school (for example in a music, drama or sporting event, parent evenings, trips etc)	 Member of staff awards pupil a 'REACH' WOW postcard, this is handed to the pupil. (5 house points awarded) Member of staff indicates the REACH award through SIMS (indicating whether it is for Resilience, Effort, Aspiration, Cooperation or Honour – all are listed). This can be done through 'right-click' on the lesson register OR by going through the individual pupil's behaviour management log and 'adding achievement' – automatically adds House points 	 Member of staff to write out postcard and give to pupil. Complete the appropriate method of recording the award on SIMS 		
Lesson Grade 1 in class (5 HP)				
Pupil is rewarded for their hard work, consistent effort and engagement in lesson ✓ You have displayed an exemplary attitude to learning. ✓ You are always well prepared for your lesson and are ready to learn. ✓ You are never late to lessons. ✓ Homework is completed to the highest possible standard and is handed in on time. ✓ You actively contribute to the lesson and the school community. ✓ You constantly work hard and take pride in your work. ✓ You behave impeccably and require no behaviour intervention	 Pupil is awarded a 'B1' at the end of the lesson (please press SAVE after altering numbers) Member of staff indicates the B1 by changing the 'register' number. Member of staff 'right clicks' on SIMS register, 'add achievement' and awards 'B1 excellent achievement in lesson'. This then automatically awards 1 House Point. 	 ✓ Member of staff tells pupil of score at end of lesson. ✓ Member of staff indicates the B1 on register. ✓ Member of staff records award on SIMS, which automatically enables a House point. (Parents can see the lesson 'numbers' for each period on the Edulink App – if a '1' is awarded (or there is any change in number at the end of the lesson) and the pupil informed, this <u>MUST</u> be changed on the register) 		
Lesson Grade 4 in class				
 Pupil has been warned about their negative behaviour. You are often late to lesson without a valid reason. You cause low-level disruption occasionally in the lesson. You sometimes receive warnings and occasional 	 Pupil is given first warning for poor behaviour (see B4L criteria) this automatically places pupil on a B4. (If pupil is reminded at this point and improves his/her behaviour during the rest of the lesson time, then the member of staff may award a B2 at the end of the lesson at the discretion of the member of staff). Name is recorded with 'W1' on classroom record sheet 	 Subject Staff / FH (if supply staff) to add behaviour incident to SIMS, record pupil on SIMS lunch detention & contact home.  sanctions for breaking the School's Code of Conduct (see classroom behaviour monitor sheet) 	 Pupil is given second warning continuing with poor behaviour (see B4L criteria). Name is recorded with 'W2' on classroom record sheet Poor behaviour continues and pupil can be sent outside the class on the 3rd warning to reflect on their behaviour (up to 5 minutes – time can be indicated on classroom record sheet to ensure appropriate amount of time given) End of lesson – member of staff confirms to individual the issue of a 'B4'. Lunchtime detention issued (teacher to record on SIMS detention manager – for detention that day if issued on or before period 3. If awarded during period 4 or 5, pupil to be placed on the following day lunch detention. Class teacher to make contact with home if parent not on EDULINK (email address on SIMS). Pastoral Staff in the Hub to monitor 'edit marks' and those pupils issued with a 'B4' during the school day. Lesson Grade 5 in class		
 You have shown an unacceptable attitude to learning You are rarely on time to lessons. You disrupt the learning of others. You show little respect to others or the environment. You break the school's Code of Conduct, often receive warnings or sanctions. 	 Pupil has worked through the B4L system and been given three warnings with no improvement in behaviour during the lesson – member of staff 'calls' for support from Pastoral Hub for pupil to be removed from the class. THIS IS AUTOMATICALLY A 'B5' Pupil is removed from the lesson and escorted to Tawelfan for the rest of the day UNTIL 3.30pm. (<i>If after break time – pupil to complete full day in Tawelfan through additional periods the following day</i>) Pupil will have NO social time and lunch will be taken in Tawelfan Text message & (if possible) a phone call to parents to ensure understanding that pupil's school day has now been extended to 3.30pm 	 Tawelfan staff to add '5' to individual pupil's behaviour management log and Text message / phone call to be made home regarding late finish. Subject staff to add detail to SIMS asap following incident (this is vital for information sharing) and to alter number on register at end of lesson. Contact home to ensure parent has detail of incident.

<u>Teaching Staff</u> - If a pupil is late to your lesson, please indicate minutes late on SIMS as this will be totalled weekly (not counting the 3 minute movement time) and a lunch or pm detention issued depending on total number of minutes late. Please include in B4L judgement for lesson if persistent. <u>Late gate</u> – Pupils will be issued lunch detentions via late gate, if they are registered here at least twice in a week. <u>Form tutors</u> – if a pupil is late to form, please indicate number of minutes late on the SIMS register.

Unless they have a medical card or toilet pass, <u>students **should not** leave lessons to go to the toilet or to get a drink.</u> However, please use professional discretion and if you allow a student to leave the classroom, <u>make sure they have a note</u>.
